TerraCycle will convert the used drink pouches into unique fashion bags, tote bags, and pencil cases for kids and adults. They will also convert the Nabisco wrappers into unique accessories and other upcycled products such as purses and tote bags.

TerraCycle was started in 2001 the brainchild of two Princeton University students who wanted to change the way people do business. The company makes products entirely from recycled products or waste. Trash cans are made from recycled computer and fax machine parts; binders are made from recycled steel and paper; backpacks, pencil pouches, & lunch bags are made from recycled drink pouches. These balls will go to children in South Africa where sports ministries bring the love of Jesus Christ to many!

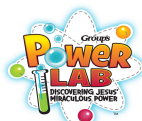
For \$10 you can sponsor a ball that our VBS children will personalize and pray over before it is sent to South Africa.
